

## Daycare Guidelines:

### 1. Evaluations

- Your dog will be evaluated the first day to decide whether we can continue daycare with your pet and if group play or individual play is best for your dog.
- Your dog may be re-evaluated if we are seeing inappropriate play behaviors with other dogs or caretakers
- We reserve the right to not allow a dog to come back to the daycare program including but not limited to, inappropriate play behaviors (mounting other dogs, aggressive behaviors, resource guardian, etc).

### 2. What to bring:

- Leash and Collar
- A snack (optional, owner provides)
- We do not feed breakfast or lunch but offer afternoon snack time if you provide the food

### 3. What your dogs day includes:

- This varied based on your daycare package (Bronze, Silver, Gold)

### 4. injury/sickness

- We will attempt to call you, if we can not get in touch we will use our judgment to decide whether we feel the dog needs care right away.
- If we find that a dog seems sick, looks unwell or is acting not themselves we will attempt contacting you and will take the dog out of group play in the meantime for the rest of the day.
- Dog fights can happen when pets are out in a group setting with other dogs. We watch them and look for any signals indicating a dog may be unsettled so we can refocus their mind on something else however, dogs can still get into a squabble for many reasons, some being; a dog is not respecting others boundaries, they are getting too stimulated, accidental behavior to another dog. So although play is observed we want to be very clear that an injury, by activity or dogfight may/can still happen.
- The owner is responsible for their dog(s) health and their actions before, during, and after daycare.

### 5. Dogs in Heat

- We do not allow dogs in heat to come to Daycare. Please wait a full 1-2 months to come back to group play.

### 6. Lack of Attendance

- You are required to pick a daycare package monthly to reserve your daycare spot.
- We require you to come at least once a week to make sure your dog stays familiar with all the daycare dogs and staff
- Lack of attendance may result in not being able to attend daycare in the future
